



Summary

Kaddra Farm Inc., is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that supports and invests in the sustainability and the improvement of living conditions, stability, health, education and economic growth in the rural population of four communities in Gbinle-Dixian chiefdom in Kambia District Sierra Leone West Africa. We created “The Water-well Project” to build 10 water-wells with hand pump devices for the people living in Sierra Leona, West Africa Our team efforts are to prevent communities from being forced to drink dirty water due to climate change, which leads to illness, disease and ultimately death. Our goal is to aid these families and farmers in crisis gain access to clean water and healthy sanitation practices by building water-wells.

Challenge

Sierra Leone, West Africa has gone through a lot of natural disasters over the past years, such as, the spread of Ebola diseases, Mudslide from heavy rain flood and now climate change. Today the shortage of water in communities is overwhelming. Water is regarded as one of the most essential resources for maintaining bodily functions and the future of the people and developmental programs in the community. If the main source of fetch water for the communities is dried out, the livelihood of its people and the community’s health and well-being will be at a dire state.

Our mission is to build water-wells and hand-pumps to bring clean water to schools, medical facilities, and farmers. The need is great! But, we believe we can end the water crisis with your help. Providing communities of Sierra Leona, West Africa, with clean water is an essential resource for

maintaining bodily functions and good health, and a mean to prevent community youths from becoming victims by walking far away to fetch dirty water for both families and animals.
