The trip was organized by Sfano Njawa Sesay-the president of Everybody Must Farm (EMF) in collaboration with Abdulai S Kamara-Executive Director of Kaddra Farm organization and the Chief Coordinator- Momoh Bangura in the same idea of facilitating a system that will provide a positive return on investment and positive impact in our country (Sierra Leone).

EMF's farmers in Bombali District embraced their President Sfano Njawa Sesay and his top executive members during their official visit in Makeni Town in Northern Province. The visit was hosted on GRACE LAND by the IEC Unit of EMF. One of the main goals, which the ILO of the United Nations has taken up, was the challenge to train up the organization members as a way out to strengthen and uplift the spirit of farmers. These approaches would enhance and sustain strong farming communities, providing skills and would maximize the ways in which they farm their lands. It would also promote healthy production, better education on business planning, micro development, successful investment, sustainability and many more.

The training is for a five-day period commencing on the third and ending on the seventh of October, 2022. The focus of these training sessions is expected to educate twenty representatives, including participants of EMF farmer's group in Bombali District.

During a brief discussion with James Koroma a member of the technical team of the ILO Opportunity Salone-Program , a legal consultant who unveiled that the project identified for investment opportunities on Palm oil, Cocoa, Vegetables and cassava in Bombali, Bo, Kenema and Portloko districts respectively.
